SUBJECT:

Chatter On Turns During Parking Lot Maneuvers

OVERVIEW:

This bulletin involves replacing the transfer case fluid and driving the vehicle in a figure eight pattern to disperse any moisture from the transfer case clutches that may have entered into the transfer case and then replace the transfer case fluid a second time.

MODELS:

2012 WK Grand Cherokee SRT 8

NOTE: This Service Bulletin applies to 2012 SRT 8 Grand Cherokee's built before October 17, 2011 (MDH 1017XX).

SYMPTOM/CONDITION:

A small number of SRT 8 Grand Cherokee's may have been built with a small amount of moisture in the transfer case fluid. Moisture in the transfer case fluid can cause a chatter in the driveline while performing parking lot maneuvers.

DIAGNOSIS:

If a customer's VIN is listed in VIP or your RRT VIN list, perform the Repair Procedure. For all other customers that describe the symptom/condition, perform the Repair Procedure.

PARTS REQUIRED:

2	04797323	Plug, Transfer Case Drain/Fill
4	05013457AA	Fluid, ATF+4, quarts

REPAIR PROCEDURE:

1. Raise vehicle on hoist.




Fig. 1 Drain Transfer Case Fluid




Fig. 2 Transfer Case Fill And Drain Plug Location

2. Place oil drain pan (Fig. 1) under drain plug (Fig. 2).

1 - Drain Pan




Fig. 3 Removing Transfer Case Drain Plug

- 3. With an 8 mm Allen Wrench, remove drain plug (Fig. 3).

- 4. Drain the oil. Allow the oil to drain approximately 8-10 minutes to allow all of the oil to drain out.
- 5. Re-install the drain plug. Tighten the drain plug to 15 22 ft. lbs. (20-34 Nm).
- 6. Remove the fill plug (Fig. 2). Then, using a suction gun, fill the transfer case with 2 quarts (1.9 liters) of Mopar ATF+4 Transmission Fluid (p/n 05013457AA).




Fig. 4 Using Suction Gun To Fill Transfer Case

- 1 Suction Gun
- 2 Mopar ATF+4 Transmission Fluid
- 7. Re-install the fill plug. Tighten the fill plug to 15 22 ft. lbs. (20-34 Nm).
- 8. Lower the vehicle.
- 9. Place the transfer case into Auto Mode. Drive the vehicle for 10 minutes at moderate speeds, including a total of 10 figure 8 full lock turn maneuvers at 5 MPH.
- 10. Return to the Service Garage and raise the vehicle on a lift.
- 11. Repeat Steps 2 4.
- 12. Install a new drain plug (p/n 04797323). Tighten the drain plug to 15 22 ft. lbs. (20-34 Nm).
- 13. Remove the fill plug (Fig. 2). Then, using a suction gun (Fig. 4), fill the transfer case with 2 quarts (1.9 liters) of Mopar ATF+4 Transmission Fluid (p/n 05013457AA).
- 14. Install a new fill plug (p/n 04797323). Tighten the fill plug to 15 22 ft. lbs. (20-34 Nm).
